

BY-LAW 423

A by-law of the Town of Daysland, Province of Alberta, to establish the position of Chief Administrative Officer.

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M – 26, R.S.A. 2000 and amendments thereto, the Council must establish, by by-law, the position of Chief Administrative Officer;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Daysland, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. The position of Chief Administrative Officer for the Town of Daysland, pursuant to Section 205 of the Municipal Government Act, is hereby established.
2. The position of Chief Administrator Officer shall be referred to as the “C.A.O.” or “Town Administrator”.
3. The appointment of a Chief Administrative Officer shall be by resolution of Council.
4. The position of Chief Administrative Officer shall be given responsibilities pursuant to Section 207 of the Municipal Government Act.
5. The position of Chief Administrative Officer shall be given duties pursuant to Section 208 of the Municipal Government Act.
6. The position of Chief Administrative Officer shall be given authorities pursuant to Section 209 and Section 213 of the Municipal Government Act.
7. That By-Law G232 and By-Law 394 are hereby rescinded.
8. That this By-Law shall come into force and take effect upon final reading.
