

## BYLAW #429-01

A bylaw of the Town of Daysland, in the province of Alberta, to amend bylaw #429.

**WHEREAS** Council finds it necessary to clarify Bylaw #429

**AND WHEREAS** certain definitions need to be placed in the bylaw for clarification

**NOW THEREFORE** pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, S.A. 1994 c.M-26.1, and amendments thereto the Council of the Town of Daysland, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

### 1. **TITLE**

1.1 This Bylaw may be referred to as the "Utilities Bylaw" of the Town of Daysland.

### 2. **DEFINITIONS**

2.1 In this Bylaw,

- (a) "Dwelling" shall mean a property used primarily for residential purposes,
- (b) "Commercial Building" means a property on which a business is located and is the primary use,
- (c) "Commercial Bay" shall mean a commercial building, with a common wall whose entrance, water and sewer facilities are separate and distinct from the adjoining bay.
- (d) "Chief Administrative Officer" means the Chief Administrative Officer appointed by Council, or the Chief Administrative Officer's designate.
- (e) "Council" means the Council of the Town of Daysland;
- (g) "Apartment Building" means a building where the primary use is residential, contains three or more units that are separate and distinct from each other but shall not mean row housing.
- (h) "4 plex" shall mean an Apartment Building with four units
- (i) "Garage" shall mean a commercial business used primarily for the maintaining of vehicles

### 3. **RATES & FEES**

Rates for water shall be as outlined in Schedule "A":

### 4. **GENERAL**


- 4.1 This Bylaw shall come into force and effect upon third and final reading.
- 4.2 If any provision of this Bylaw is declared or held to be invalid, that provision shall be deemed to be severed, and the remainder of the Bylaw shall remain in force and effect.
- 4.3 Upon Third & Final Reading By-law #429 shall be repealed.
