**A DAYSLAND MEDICAL CLINIC BYLAW
OF THE TOWN OF DAYSLAND, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA**

**THE PURPOSE OF THIS BYLAW IS TO SPECIFY THE LENGTH OF TERM
FOR A FINANCIAL COMMITMENT FROM THE TOWN OF DAYSLAND
TO THE DAYSLAND HOSPITAL FOUNDATION TO FUND A MEDICAL CLINIC
IN THE TOWN OF DAYSLAND.**

WHEREAS, The Council of the Town of Daysland deems it necessary for the Town of Daysland to participate in the establishment of a new medical clinic in the Town of Daysland to better serve the medical clinic needs of the Daysland region.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Daysland understands that the Daysland Hospital Foundation intends to purchase, own and operate a new Daysland Medical Clinic over a period of time from Saik Investments Ltd.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Daysland deems it necessary to pass a bylaw to specify the amount and length of term for the financial commitment to the Daysland Hospital Foundation for the Daysland Medical Clinic.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, Statutes of Alberta, the Council of the Town of Daysland, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. That the Town of Daysland will contribute thirty-thousand-dollars (\$30,000) per year for 10 years (2010 – 2019) to the Daysland Hospital Foundation to assist in funding a new Daysland Medical Clinic.**
- 2. That this Medical Clinic funding contribution from the Town of Daysland will be raised annually through general taxation in the Town of Daysland.**
- 3. That this Bylaw comes into force and effect on the day of final passing hereof.**


