BYLAW No. 2011-495

OFF HIGHWAY VEHICLE BYLAW

OF THE TOWN OF DAYSLAND, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 7 of the *Municipal Government Act*, a council may pass bylaws for municipal purposes including the safety, health and welfare of people, and the protection of people and property;


AND WHEREAS, Daysland Town Council desires to remedy unsafe operation of off-highway vehicles within the town of Daysland, particularly snowmobiles and quads;

AND WHEREAS, the Province of Alberta, *Traffic Safety Act* regulates the driving and operation of off-highway vehicles;

NOW THEREFORE, the council of the Town of Daysland in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled hereby enacts as follows:

1. That all off-highway vehicles are prohibited from operation within the town of Daysland, except as permitted by the Province of Alberta, *Traffic Safety Act* or other Provincial Statute.
2. Bylaws 2007-468 and 2007-470-1 are hereby repealed.
