OF THE TOWN OF DAYSLAND, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA**


**THE PURPOSE OF THIS BYLAW IS TO AMEND LAND USE BYLAW
2010-482 TO EXPAND THE DISCRETIONARY USES IN THE C-1
DISTRICT OF THE TOWN OF DAYSLAND.**

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable to amend the Land Use Bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Daysland duly assembled, pursuant to the authority conferred upon it by the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26, and amendments thereto, enacts as follows:

1. That Land Use Bylaw 2010-482 is hereby amended as follows:
2. That the C-1 Central Commercial zoning in the town of Daysland Land Use Bylaw 2010-482 shall include a "Gas Bar" as a discretionary use.
3. That if any provision of this bylaw is deemed invalid, then such provision shall be severed and the remaining bylaw shall be maintained.
4. That this bylaw comes into force and effect on the day of final passing thereof.
