

TOWN OF DAYSLAND

BYLAW No. 2012-503

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF DAYSLAND IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FOR THE NUMBER OF COUNCILLORS AND THE ELECTION OF CHIEF ELECTED OFFICIAL.

WHEREAS, Section of 143(2) of the Municipal Government Act, RSA 2000, C M-26 as amended from time to time, provides that a Council of a City or Town consist of 7 councillors unless the council passes a bylaw specifying a higher or lower odd number.

AND WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Daysland under Bylaw 459 currently provides that the Municipal Council of the Town of Daysland shall consist of seven (7) councillors, one of whom is the Chief Elected Official; the Chief Elected Official shall be appointed by Council from among Councillors;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Town of Daysland duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. The Municipal Council of the Town of Daysland shall consist of five (5) councillors, one of whom is the Chief Elected Official.
2. The Chief Elected Official shall be elected by the eligible electors of the Town of Daysland as a whole.
3. The Chief Elected Official shall have the same term as other councillors.
4. This by-law shall take effect at the time of the next general election.
5. Bylaw #459 shall hereby be repealed upon this Bylaw #503 taking effect.
