BYLAW No. 2019-647

A MILL RATE BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF DAYSLAND, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

THE PURPOSE OF THIS BYLAW IS TO AUTHORIZE THE RATES OF TAXATION TO BE LEVIED AGAINST ASSESSABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE TOWN OF DAYSLAND FOR THE 2019 TAXATION YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Daysland Town Council has adopted detailed budget estimates of municipal revenues and expenditures at the May 6th, 2019 council meeting, and;

WHEREAS, the **estimated expenditures and transfers** set out in the budget for operations for the Town of Daysland total **\$2,506,286 and \$415,000 for capital work.**

WHEREAS, the **estimated 2019 municipal revenues and transfers** from all sources other than property taxation is estimated at **\$1,438,831**, for operations exclusive of amortization is to be raised by general municipal taxation and;

WHEREAS, the following table shows the assessed value of all lands and improvements, municipal levies, requisitions, and respective tax rates for taxable properties within the Town of Daysland;

NOW, THEREFORE, under the authority and subject to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, the Council of the Town of Daysland, in the Province of Alberta, **DULY ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. THAT, the Chief Administrative Officer is hereby authorized to levy on the assessed value of all land and improvements as shown on the assessment roll for the Town of Daysland using the **2019 Mill rates** as shown in this bylaw on the above table.


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2. That a minimum amount payable per parcel as property tax for general municipal purposes shall be:
 - \$800 for Non-Residential properties (75 properties)
 - \$800 for Residential properties (22 properties)
3. This bylaw comes into force and effect on the day of final passing thereof.
