

BYLAW 2020-656

BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF DAYSLAND, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADOPTING THE FLAGSTAFF COUNTY / TOWN OF DAYSLAND / VILLAGE OF FORESTBURG INTERMUNICIPAL COLLABORATION FRAMEWORK.

WHEREAS Pursuant to Part 17.2 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26 of the Statutes of Alberta, hereinafter referred to as the Act, municipalities that have common boundaries must, by adopting matching bylaws, create an Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework, hereinafter referred to as ICF, with each other; and

WHEREAS the MGA allows municipalities that do not have common boundaries to be party to an ICF;

WHEREAS the Town of Daysland deems it to be in the public interest to adopt the Flagstaff County / Town of Daysland / Village of Forestburg Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Town of Daysland duly assembled enacts as follows:

THAT THE FLAGSTAFF COUNTY / TOWN OF DAYSLAND / VILLAGE OF FORESTBURG INTERMUNICIPAL COLLABORATION FRAMEWORK, AS ATTACHED AND FORMING PART OF THIS BYLAW BE ADOPTED.

THIS BYLAW SHALL COME INTO EFFECT UPON THIRD AND FINAL READING THEREOF AND THE MATCHING BYLAW APPROVED AND SIGNED BY THE TOWN OF DAYSLAND AND VILLAGE OF FORESTBURG.

READ A FIRST TIME this 23rd day of March, 2020.

READ A SECOND TIME this 23rd day of March, 2020.

UNANIMOUS CONSENT for third and final reading this 23rd day of March, 2020.

READ A THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 23rd day of March, 2020.
