

**BYLAW 2023-04
TOWN OF DAYSLAND
PROVINCE OF ALBERTA**

**BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF DAYSLAND OF THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO
ESTABLISH AN INTERMUNICIPAL SUBDIVISION AND DEVELOPMENT APPEAL BOARD FOR
THE VILLAGE OF ALLIANCE, THE VILLAGE OF AMISK, THE TOWN OF DAYSLAND, FLAGSTAFF
COUNTY, THE VILLAGE OF FORESTBURG, THE TOWN OF HARDISTY, THE VILLAGE OF
HEISLER, THE TOWN OF KILLAM, THE VILLAGE OF LOUGHEED AND THE TOWN OF
SEDEGWICK**

WHEREAS Section 627 of the *Municipal Government Act* authorizes a municipality to enter into an agreement with one or more municipalities to establish an intermunicipal subdivision and development appeal board;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Daysland deems it beneficial to establish an intermunicipal subdivision and development appeal board to hear subdivision and development appeals;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Daysland hereby enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the "Flagstaff Regional Subdivision and Development Appeal Board Bylaw".
2. The Town of Daysland is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement between the Village of Alliance, the Village of Amisk, the Town of Daysland, Flagstaff County, the Village of Forestburg, the Town of Hardisty, the Village of Heisler, the Town of Killam, the Village of Lougheed and the Town of Sedgewick (the "Municipalities") to provide for the following:
 - (a) the hearing of subdivision appeals and development appeals arising within the boundaries of the Municipalities;
 - (b) the procedure and conduct of the Flagstaff Regional Subdivision and Development Appeal Board and its members; and
 - (c) the functions and duties of the Flagstaff Regional Subdivision and Development Appeal Board.
3. The position of clerk is established for the purpose of carrying out the powers, duties and functions of the clerk in accordance with the *Municipal Government Act* and the Flagstaff Regional Subdivision and Development Appeal Board agreement. The Council of the Town of Daysland delegates to the Chief Administrative Officer the authority to appoint one or more clerks to the Flagstaff Regional Subdivision and Development Appeal Board in accordance with the Flagstaff Regional Subdivision and Development Appeal Board agreement.
4. This Bylaw becomes effective on the date it is signed and passed.




5. This Bylaw Repeals Bylaw No. 425, Bylaw No. 2019-648 and Bylaw No. 2020-660, and any amendments thereto.
