March 22, 2022 Council Meeting Highlights

- Council is looking forward to meeting with local boards to discuss their current operating structure etc., to review in an effort to build an understanding and rapport with these community leaders in our Community.
- Daysland Library appointments were updated.
- Council is considering purchasing a recognition of service commemorative bench at the cemetery for volunteers.
- The Lift Station is still on target for June 30 completion date. Pricing is still on target.
- Council has directed the CAO to investigate increasing the proposed minimum tax rate from \$800 to \$1000 to reallocate proposed funding to increase street maintenance and repairs budget from \$51,500 to \$75,000, and to include an allowance for cemetery maintenance and repairs.

PEACHY DUTCH PANCAKE

2 CUPS FRESH OR FROZEN THINLY SLICED PEACHES, THAWED & DRAINED
3/4 TSP SALT
1/4 CUP BUTTER, CUBED
1 1/4 CUPS FAT-FREE MILK
1 1/4 CUPS ALL-PURPOSE FLOUR
4 LARGE EGGS
1/2 TSP ALMOND EXTRACT
1/2 CUP SUGAR
WARM PEACH PRESERVES & MAPLE SYRUP

DIRECTIONS:

1. PREHEAT OVEN TO 425 DEGREES. PLACE BUTTER IN A 13X9 INCH BAKING DISH. PLACE IN OVEN 3-4 MINUTES OR UNTIL BUTTER IS MELTED, CAREFULLY SWIRL TO COAT BOTTOM & SIDES OF DISH. CAREFULLY ADD PEACHES, RETURN TO OVEN FOR 3-4 MINUTES OR UNTIL BUBBLY.
2. MEANWHILE, IN A LARGE BOWL, WHISK EGGS UNTIL FROTHY. ADD MILK & EXTRACT.. WHISK IN FLOUR, SUGAR & SALT. POUR INTO HOT BAKING DISH. BAKE 10-12 MINUTES OR UNTIL PUFFED & SIDES ARE GOLDEN BROWN.
3. REMOVE FROM OVEN, SERVE IMMEDIATELY WITH PRESERVES & SYRUP.

*** TO MAKE AHEAD, PREPARE PANCAKE BATTER AS DIRECTED. REFRIGERATE, COVERED, SEVERAL HOURS OR OVERNIGHT. REMOVE FROM FRIDGE 30 MINUTES BEFORE BAKING. PREHEAT OVEN TO 425 DEGREES. PREPARE BAKING DISH AS DIRECTED. WHISK BATTER UNTIL BLENDED, POUR INTO HOT BAKING DISH. BAKE, AS DIRECTED, UNTIL PUFFED & SIDES ARE GOLDEN BROWN
