January 25, 2022 Council Meeting Highlights

- Council accepted the Interim CAO Contract as submitted.
- Bylaw 2021-670 to establish the position of Chief Administrative Officer was approved.
- Council approved the lease of the Daysland Fire Hall to Flagstaff Regional Emergency Services Society.
- The snow removal level of service policy will be drafted using the “Guide to Establishing a Level of Service Policy for Municipal Roads”, in conjunction with council and the Public Works Committee.
- Council approved the terms of the lease of the ATB building.

SNOW REMOVAL REMINDER

- Sidewalks **must** be cleared within 48 hours of a snowfall, so please make sure your sidewalks are free of snow and ice. Please consider this a warning, as a ticket will be issued if this is not done.
- Please do not shovel snow from driveways and sidewalks onto the town streets, this will keep the roads more travelable & will provide more moisture for your own lawns.
- The Town of Daysland Public Works is very busy in the winter removing snow. Public Works will be there as soon as they can to remove the snow from your street, so please be patient.
- Please make sure trees and shrubs are not overhanging on sidewalks, roadways, or alleys to ensure the grader is able to access these roads and alleys for snow removal purposes.
- Public Works is unable to plough your residential side street with parked vehicles on it, they will place signs on your street the night before they plough. **PLEASE** move your vehicles so that the town vehicles can move freely and safely to remove the snow.

Owning and Operating a Small Vehicle In Alberta Re: Prohibited Miniature Vehicles

- These vehicles are motor vehicles as defined in the **Alberta Traffic Safety Act**, however they also meet the definition of "miniature vehicles" **which are not permitted** on a highway in Alberta. Highway includes street, avenues and alleys. Miniature vehicles may only be operated on private property. **PROHIBITED MINIATURE VEHICLES INCLUDE:** Personal transporter, pocket bikes, go carts, electric scooters and golf carts.

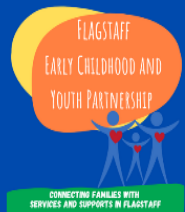

On August 16th, Town Council had the opportunity to meet with members of Alberta Health Services (AHS) Assertive Outreach program covering eastern Central Alberta. This particular team helps clients with severe and persistent mental illness improve or maintain their ability to function in the community. Nurses on the team will work with the most vulnerable and complex clients to connect them with the health, social and economic supports they need.

Individuals face many degrees of mental health challenges in all of our communities. If undiagnosed, those challenges may lead to addiction to drugs and alcohol. Many times, mental health issues go untreated because of misperceptions. But this is changing, and the public is starting to understand that mental health issues are no different than any other ailments. mental health issues can be treated.. There are many good medications and counsellors available that can support our residents in living productive and happy lives.

BEEF STEW

2 LBS STEWING BEEF, TRIMMED & CUBED
1/2 TSP GARLIC POWDER
1/2 CUP RED WINE (OPTIONAL)
3 TBSP OLIVE OIL
6 CUPS BEEF BROTH
1 LB POTATOES, (PEELED & CUBED)
4 CARROTS CUT IN 1 INCH PCES
4 STALKS CELERY, CUT IN 1 INCH PCES
1 TSP DRIED ROSEMARY OR 1 FRESH SPRIG

3 TBSP FLOUR
1/2 TSP SALT
1/2 TSP BLACK PEPPER
1 ONION CHOPPED
3 TBSP TOMATO PASTE
2 TBSP CORNSTARCH
2 TBSP WATER
3/4 CUP PEAS

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Combine flour, garlic powder & salt & pepper. Toss beef in flour mixture.
2. Heat olive oil in a large Dutch oven or pot. Cook the beef & onions until browned.
3. Add beef broth & red wine while scraping up any brown bits in the pan.
4. Stir in all remaining ingredients except for peas, cornstarch and water. Reduce heat to medium low, cover & simmer 1 hour or until beef is tender (up to 90 minutes).
5. Mix equal parts cornstarch & water to create a slurry. Slowly add the slurry to the boiling stew to reach desired consistency (you may not need all of the slurry).
6. Stir in peas & simmer 5-10 minutes before serving. Season with salt & pepper to taste.
