February 22, 2022 Council Meeting Highlights

- Presentation from John Dickau updating Council & Administration on the works of the Daysland Walking Trail Committee Volunteers. Committee is looking for volunteers to help with some trail maintenance & mat installation as well as looking for renewed support from the new Council & Administration as it relates to keeping the walking trails a community enhancement project.
Council accepted the 2yr extension of the Municipal Sustainability Initiative Program funding from the Province of Alberta to March 2024.
Council renewed their Gas Utility Quality Management Plan with the Province of Alberta in order to continue delivering natural gas service to Town of Daysland residents.
Council directed administration to work with AHS/Daysland Health Center & STARS to create a temporary landing zone for STARS on municipal land located across from the Health Centre.
Council donates \$200 as a sponsorship to the Farm Safety Centre to continue the education programming in rural schools & communities as it relates to farm safety practice, and overall health for rural families.
Council directs administration to draft a letter to Municipal Affairs - Minister of Justice & Solicitor General advocating and supporting to keep RCMP services in Alberta due to the projected costs of moving to an Alberta Provincial Police model.

SNOW REMOVAL REMINDER

- Sidewalks **must** be cleared within 48 hours of a snowfall, so please make sure your sidewalks are free of snow and ice. Please consider this a warning, as a ticket will be issued if this is not done.
- Please do not shovel snow from driveways and sidewalks onto the town streets, this will keep the roads more travelable & will provide more moisture for your own lawns.
- The Town of Daysland Public Works is very busy in the winter removing snow. Public Works will be there as soon as they can to remove the snow from your street, so please be patient.
- Please make sure trees and shrubs are not overhanging on sidewalks, roadways, or alleys to ensure the grader is able to access these roads and alleys for snow removal purposes.
- Public Works is unable to plough your residential side street with parked vehicles on it, they will place signs on your street the night before they plough. **PLEASE** move your vehicles so that the town vehicles can move freely and safely to remove the snow.

Owning and Operating a Small Vehicle In Alberta Re: Prohibited Miniature Vehicles

- These vehicles are motor vehicles as defined in the **Alberta Traffic Safety Act**, however they also meet the definition of "miniature vehicles" **which are not permitted** on a highway in Alberta. Highway includes street, avenues and alleys. Miniature vehicles may only be operated on private property. **PROHIBITED MINIATURE VEHICLES INCLUDE:** Personal transporter, pocket bikes, go carts, electric scooters and golf carts.

On August 16th, Town Council had the opportunity to meet with members of Alberta Health Services (AHS) Assertive Outreach program covering eastern Central Alberta. This particular team helps clients with severe and persistent mental illness improve or maintain their ability to function in the community. Nurses on the team will work with the most vulnerable and complex clients to connect them with the health, social and economic supports they need.

Individuals face many degrees of mental health challenges in all of our communities. If undiagnosed, those challenges may lead to addiction to drugs and alcohol. Many times, mental health issues go untreated because of misperceptions. But this is changing, and the public is starting to understand that mental health issues are no different than any other ailments. Mental health issues can be treated. There are many good medications and counsellors available that can support our residents in living productive and happy lives. Assertive Outreach is just one of many programs and services AHS offers. GROUND BEEF STROGANOFF

1 LB LEAN GROUND BEEF	1/2 CUP ONION, DICED
1 TSP GARLIC, MINCED	3 TBSP BUTTER
3 TBSP FLOUR	1/2 CUPS BEEF BROTH
1 CUP SOUR CREAM	1 CAN CREAM OF MUSHROOM SOUP
SALT & PEPPER, TO TASTE	EGG NOODLES, COOKED
1 CAN DRAINED, RINSED MUSHROOMS	

- 1) BRING A POT OF WATER TO BOIL & BEGIN TO COOK EGG NOODLES ACCORDING TO PACKAGE DIRECTIONS.
- 2) IN A LARGE SKILLET OVER MEDIUM HIGH HEAT, BROWN GROUND BEEF ALONG WITH THE ONIONS AND GARLIC UNTIL THOROUGHLY COOKED.
- 3) DRAIN GROUND BEEF TO REMOVE EXCESS GREASE FROM PAN. PUT PAN BACK ON STOVE OVER MEDIUM HEAT (DON'T ADD THE GROUND BEEF BACK IN YET.)
- 4) ADD BUTTER TO PAN & ALLOW IT TO MELT. THEN ADD FLOUR TO PAN, WHISK AND LET IT ABSORB BUTTER.
- 5) ADD BEEF BROTH & WHISK VIGOROUSLY TO REMOVE ANY LUMPS, TURNING THE HEAT UP TO HIGH, BRINGING IT TO A BOIL FOR 2-3 MINUTES UNTIL YOU SEE IT THICKEN SLIGHTLY.
- 6) BRING TEMPERATURE DOWN TO MEDIUM & WHISK IN SOUR CREAM & SOUP. STIR MIXTURE THOROUGHLY.
- 7) ADD BEEF TO SAUCE & STIR.
- 8) ADD SALT & PEPPER TO TASTE. IF TOO THICK, ADD A TAD MORE BEEF BROTH.
