SNOW REMOVAL REMINDER



- Sidewalks <u>must</u> be cleared within 48 hours of a snowfall, so
 please make sure your sidewalks are free of snow and ice.
- Please do not shovel snow from driveways and sidewalks onto the town roads or alleys, this will keep the roads safer for vehicles.
- Public Works is busy in the winter removing snow. Staff will be there as soon as they can to remove snow from your street, please be patient.
- Please make sure trees and shrubs are not overhanging on sidewalks, roadways, or alleys to assist with snow removal.
- Public Works is unable to plough your residential road effectively with parked vehicles on it. <u>PLEASE</u> move your vehicles if you can when equipment is present, so that the town equipment can move freely and safely to remove the snow.


